

Serving More Communities in Colorado

As you may recall, providing opportunities for future credit union growth is a priority of the long-term objectives of our charter as a state of Colorado credit union charter. I am pleased to report that we have recently made significant progress in this area. In April, Colorado's Department of Financial Services approved expanding Ent's field of membership to include individuals who live, work, worship or attend school in Arapahoe, Douglas, Fremont and Jefferson Counties. We will gradually be adding ATM and service center locations in these new communities over the next few years as part of the credit union's long-term strategic growth plan. Ent's management team is currently exploring potential service center locations in the Castle Rock area in Douglas County.

New Service Center in Pueblo West

As part of our efforts to enhance the credit union's convenience for Pueblo area members, we recently began construction of a new service center in Pueblo West. This full-service location, which will anticipate opening before the end of the year, will include multiple service drive-up lanes as well as safe vaults with biometric access for increased member convenience.

Our Ongoing Commitment to Community

As an organization, all of Ent's activities can be traced back to how well they reflect these three core values: service, community and responsibility. It is our mission to be a member-centric, forward-thinking, community-oriented organization. It is our commitment to our members and the organization. And it is our responsibility to be a community-oriented organization. We believe that our commitment to the community is an integral part of who we are as a credit union. In this quarter's update, I'd like to share the results of our most recent community fundraising effort and an opportunity for you to get involved with us this fall.

Springs Rescue Mission Fundraising Campaign Exceeds Goal

This summer, Ent members and employees raised nearly \$40,000 in support of Springs Rescue Mission's "Building a Community of Hope" campaign to expand their downtown Colorado Springs campus. Community contributions, the separate still more than double the Mission's fundraising goals from \$20 to \$40 and allow it to provide shelter and meals -- and just during the winter. During Ent's two-month fundraising campaign, employees held a variety of events at local service centers, from bake sales to Friday "meal days" to support the effort, and many members and early participants in these events also made individual contributions, helping us exceed our \$30,000 fundraising goal.

Helping Fight Hunger

Earlier this year, Ent was recognized by Case and State Food Bank of Southern Colorado with a 2016 Hunger Hope Award. The award recognized community supporters who have Case and State's Hunger Hope Initiative to bridge the gap between hunger and abundance. Ent was cited for its long-term commitment and support, including funding for the Children's Nutrition Initiative program, funding annual holiday food drives for service centers, supporting employee "Share a Smile" to help Case collect money and cash donations, and supporting the annual Recipe for Hope fundraising luncheon.

This fall, we invite you to participate with our employees in our annual food drive in November and December. All Ent service centers will be collecting monetary donations as well as serving as collection points for non-perishable food donations.

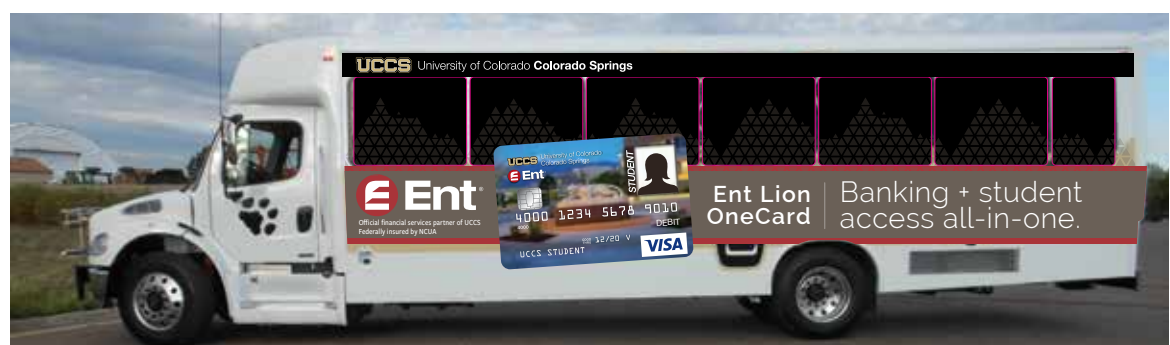
