# **Terms of Membership Agreement**

The following changes are effective immediately:

By maintaining membership and any accounts or loans at Credit Union 1, you agree that the credit union and its third party representatives have permission to call you using live representatives or automated dialing systems and to leave messages (including pre-recorded messages) at any telephone number you have given the credit union, if the call relates to transactions and services you have with the credit union. If you have

given the credit union a mobile telephone number, you agree that the credit union may communicate with you by telephone call or text messages and your carrier may charge fees to receive calls or text messages. You must at all times provide the credit union with at least one telephone number at which you can be reached during business hours.
