No one likes overdraft fees. We're restructuring ours to make the unexpected overage more affordable.

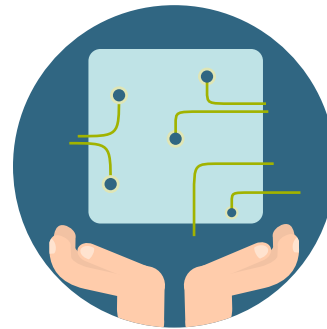


Home Loan Options

One thing that will never change at CU1 is our love for fellow Alaskans. Follow us on social media to learn who we're helping, when and where.

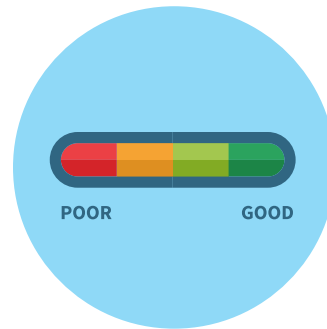


Online Learning
